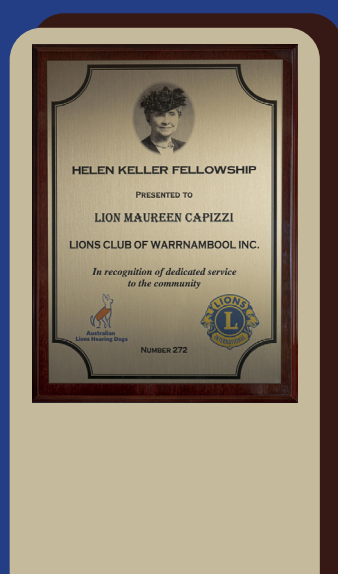
In 2006 Lions Assistance Dogs established the Helen Keller Fellowship as a way to acknowledge those who have provided a dedicated service to the community.

Through her lifetime Helen Keller was a strong advocate for people with disabilities. Her work greatly impacted the Deaf community, and she travelled to twenty-five different countries giving motivational speeches about Deaf people's conditions.

The Helen Keller Fellowship offers a unique plaque, designed and organised by Lions Assistance Dogs, engraved with a name of your choice. The plaque is created to honour someone of your choosing.
